### AMENDED AND RESTATED FEE RESOLUTION NUMBER 0207-24

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2024, City Council amended and re-stated said Fee Resolution 0159-23 of January 2024, to include amending and re-stating the Fee Resolution attached hereto, to include an increase in parking rates by the Altoona Parking Authority, adding an AFD Fireworks Display Permit Fee and increasing CPR Training Fees, restructuring the Permits section and increasing Permit Fees, increasing Home Based Business Zoning Fees and Containerized Storage Fees, increasing Foreclosed Property Registration Fees, increasing Rental Inspection No Show Fee, and increasing Sexually Oriented Business Annual Permit Renewal Fee, increasing the Right of Way Street Restoration Fee, increasing various Utilities Fees and updating language as follows:
